





Details / How-To

1. Navigate to Orchestrated Advanced QC → Cleaning and Sanitation → Grundy Records

Full should be used for a nuke & sani. CIP for just a partial. Checks are also provided for CO2 Purge, and whether additional parts of the grundy were cleaned.
