

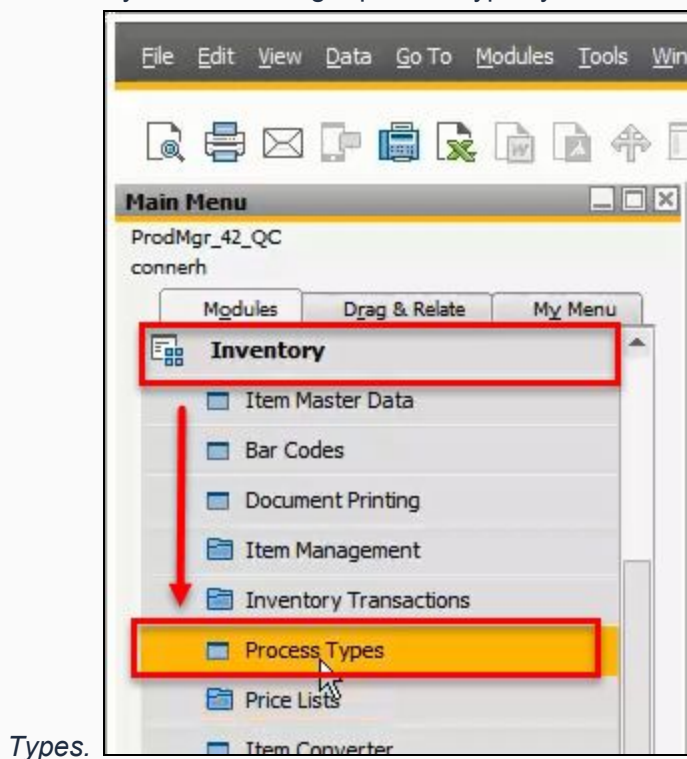


Summary

This article will walk you through if you are trying to start a production run with a "first stage" item and the wizard cannot assign a batch ID.

How To

- To identify what "first stage" process types you have, navigate to *Inventory* → *Process*





- Next identify which *Process Types* are defined with a 1 as their process order. These types are considered "first stage".
